u...stop and consider the wondrous works of..... God." - Job 37:14

TIMES AND SEASONS

Earlier this week it felt more like Winter than Fall.

- Our family got into the mood to decorate for Christmas—so we did.
- The temperatures earlier this week were in the 20s and 30s, and that wind chill was brutal (I actually had to turn the heat on in the offices at camp).
- · We even had snow on Monday and Tuesday!

It's not even Thanksgiving and I'm already thinking about and feeling like winter.



This got me thinking about seasons and the changing of seasons. When we think about the different seasons (Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter), they all have one thing in common:

CHANGE.

Seasons = Change.

Seasons are inevitable, which means change is inevitable.

Ecclesiastes 3:1

For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven:

Solomon isn't talking about Summer, Fall, Winter, and Spring, because he says that "for EVERYTHING there is a season."



If you look at the list that follows in Ecclesiastes 3, Solomon is talking about the seasons of life. Granted, the analogy of the change of physical seasons is perfect to illustrate the seasons of life and that fact that change comes.

So, as we observe the literal changing of the seasons, what can we learn about life—and change?

SEASONS ARE APPOINTED BY GOD

Genesis 1:14

And God said, "Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night. And let them be for signs and for seasons, and for days and years,

Not only is God in control of the seasons, but He appoints their time of arrival and their time of departure. A season cannot come without Him making it come and it cannot end unless He makes it end.

God is in control and appoints the times of change—even if we don't like it or even if we aren't ready for it.

The fact is that seasons will come—which means change will come. "Ready or not, here it comes!"

Even if those seasons and changes catch us off-guard, we must realize that they don't catch God off-guard.

The new season, the change, has come exactly when and in the way that God wanted it to come!

SEASONS HAVE A PURPOSE

Proverbs 16:4

The LORD has made everything for its purpose, even the wicked for the day of trouble.

This means that the cycle of seasons (summer, fall, winter, spring) all serve a purpose.

What is the overall purpose for the change of seasons? **GROWTH**

As the seasons come and go, it is a constant cycle of renewal for continued growth. The change in seasons is essential to the continual growth of our ecosystem!

A guy by the name of Leonard Sweet said this about change, "What is the difference between a living thing and a dead thing? In the medical world, a clinical definition of death is a body that does not change. Change is life. Stagnation is death. If you don't change, you die. It's that simple. It's that scary."

If you don't change, you die. This is why the change of seasons is so important. If our ecosystem does not go through its changes, it will die.

It is the same with the seasons of life. We will all experience various times and seasons throughout our life—both good and bad—and every one of these times, seasons, and changes are for the purpose of continued growth.

Every season that we go through in life, every change that we have to experience, tears us down in order to refine us, renew us, and help us to grow stronger.

SEASONS DON'T LAST FOREVER

The seasons come and the seasons go...Summer eventually turns into Fall. Fall eventually turns into Winter. Winter eventually turns into Spring. Spring eventually turns into Summer.

No one season lasts forever. No one change is permanent. You don't just go through one change, but you will experience multiple seasons and changes in life.

2 Corinthians 4:17-18

For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal.

Whatever season you are in life right now, be encouraged—it will eventually pass, change will come, and a new season of life will emerge for the purpose of your continual growth.

SEASONS INEVITABLY COME BACK AROUND

Everyone knows that after Summer always comes Fall; after Fall always comes Winter; after Winter always comes Spring; and Summer will always come back after Spring.

It's a continual cycle. Seasons will always come back around. You will always experience change.

Sometimes the Winters are not as bad as the previous Winter. Sometimes the Summer isn't as hot as the previous. No matter the change in the degree of the season, the fact is, the season always comes back around. You can count on the fact that the next season is around the corner. You can be assured that a change in the works.
